## WORKSHOP Pe'le Me'le Quilt



Véronique has been quilting for the past 2 2years and making patterns for the past 10 years. Véronique has won runner-up in the traditional section in 2009 at the Victorian Quilt showcase (with a whole cloth quilt) and had a quilt entered at Paducah Quilt show in 2010 (trapunto and appliqué). After that she has been busy designing patterns to enter anything in competition. Véronique has been teaching appliqué, embroidery since 2011.



The "Pêle-Mêle" pattern is a wonderful way to try a lot of different techniques without having to make a whole quilt. Through all the classes I have been teaching, I have demonstrated applique, broderie perse, embroidery, paper piecing, and mostly to play with fabrics of all different styles. It is like opening a Pandora Box for the quilters, they are only limited by their imaginations (and some have lots of it). Pêle-Mêle comes in three different patterns, repro, brights and embroidery.
